

Sub:- LAND ASSIGNMENT - Maintenance of Special Registers relating to Land Assignment in Village Offices - Common forms prescribed.

According to the additional questionnaire on Land Assignment work prescribed for Jamabandy Inspection, four registers are to be maintained in the Village Offices. As no proforma in which the registers are to be maintained have been prescribed, these registers are now being maintained in the Village Offices under different titles and forms.

2. The District Collector, Malappuram in his letter cited has forwarded specimen forms for the registers and requested for their approval so as to have uniformity throughout the State. These registers are in addition to the Special Register prescribed by the Board in its Circular cited.

3. The Board has ascertained the views of the other District Collectors on the suggestion of the District Collector, Malappuram. The District Collectors Alleppey, Kozhikode, Palghat, Quilon and Ernakulam have stated that proforma suggested by the District Collector, Malappuram are acceptable. The District Collectors, Cannanore, Kottayam, Trichur and Trivandrum have forwarded their suggestion with slight modification to the registers to be maintained.

4. The Board has examined the question in all its aspects and found it necessary to have uniformity for the registers to be maintained in Villages throughout the State. Taking into consideration of the proposals made by the District Collector, Malappuram and also the modification suggested by other District Collectors, the following four registers are hereby prescribed; to be maintained in the Village Offices.

- REGISTER NO. I. Register showing the extent of land available for assignment.
- REGISTER NO. II. Register showing the details of application received for assignment of land.
- REGISTER NO. III. Register showing the details of land assignment dues collected.
- REGISTER NO. IV. Register showing the details of trees reserved to Government and of special condition imposed for the land assigned under the K.L.A. Rules.

5. In order to limit the total number of Special Registers to four, slight modification has been effected to the Special Register prescribed in Board's Circular cited as I paper above and it is allowed to continue as Register No. IV as now prescribed.
