ORDER

As per the Government Order read as first paper above, Government have accorded sanction to set up Revenue Institute at PTP Nagar, Thiruvananthapuram. The institute was established as an autonomous institute namely State Institute of Revenue Administration, Kerala and registered under the Travancore – Cochin literary scientific and charitable societies registration Act, 1955. Later as per the Government Order read as second paper above the name of the Institute was changed to Institute of Land Management.

(2) H.E, the Governor of Kerala in his address to Kerala Legislative Assembly on 16.06.2006 has stated that Kerala had been included in the disaster prone map as a multi hazard prone State by Government of India. Natural Disaster like drought, floods, sea-erosion, landslides etc, are on the increase. In order to effectively co-ordinate and implement the disaster mitigation programmes a Disaster Management Training Institute would be established.

(3) The Hon'ble Minister for Finance in his budget speech presented to the Assembly as per the paper read as 4th above stated that to evolve a scientific approach in creating awareness in Disaster Management and mitigation and capacity

building, the Institute of Land Management under the Revenue Department will be upgraded to a Disaster Management Institute.

(4) Reflecting the spirit of H.E, the Governor's address to Kerala Legislative Assembly and in conformity with the declaration of the Hon'ble Minister for Finance, the Governing Body of the Institute in its meeting held on 16/09/2006 has decided to rename the Institute of Land Management as Institute of Land and Disaster Management and to make amendment in the Memorandum of Association accordingly. Therefore, Director, Institute of Land Management in his letter read as sixth paper above has requested Government to issue formal orders renaming the Institute of Land Management as Institute of Land and Disaster Management.

(5) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to rename the Institute of Land Management as Institute of Land and Disaster Management so as to enable the Institute to effectively co-ordinate and implement disaster mitigation programmes, capacity building, relief activities and to propose and submit projects to funding agencies and to conduct studies and disaster related activities.

(6) The Director, Institute of Land and Disaster Management will make necessary formal arrangements to make suitable amendments in the Memorandum of Association of the Institute.
